Guided Tours



These must be booked in advance. Groups of 15 or more must have a guided tour.

They can be general or topic specific. Duration approximate. 1 hour and include:

- Goat milking demonstration (mornings only).
- Feed for animals.
- Opportunity to stroke some of our rabbits, guinea pigs, hens, goats & sheep.
- Friendly & informative tour leaders.
- Wheelchair accessible sheds plus viewing sheds with low level windows.
- Resource Room for use of school groups (limited seating available).

Want to make a day of it? Use our woodland walk (trail leaflet available to guide yourself around) or give the children an opportunity for a Horse Ride at £2.00 per head. Goat's milk ice-cream can also be pre-ordered at just £1.20 a tub.
